# Day 1 Plan: September 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022 (8:16 - 11:16)

Note: September 6<sup>th</sup> will be a half day for Grades 1-7 and busses will run three hours early. Supervision will start at 7:45am. All students will make their way to the back fields where they will be met by their teachers and friends. Students can place their belongings in their grade groups (signage will be setup for easy visuals) and then go play on the playground or in the field. For the first day of school, students will only need a snack, water, and to be dressed for the weather. Teachers will collect their students and lead them into the school through their designated entrances.

## Kindergarten Plan:

September 6<sup>th</sup>: Welcome to Kindergarten 2:00 – 3:30 (Meet in Library)

Wednesday, September 7<sup>th</sup>, is the first day of our Kindergarten gradual entry. Classes are divided into two groups, A & B. If you have not received your gradual entry schedule, please call the office for more information. Our Kindergarten students will be in school full time on Monday, September 19<sup>th</sup>. ## **Class Placements:**

Due to the many changes that have taken place over the summer in terms of new registrations, transfers, and families who have moved outside of our catchment area, we will not be placing students in their homerooms on the first day. Instead, students will be placed in their grade groupings and provided with community-building and learning activities led by our wonderful teachers. This structure will allow us the time necessary to make well-balanced classes moving forward. Depending on our Day 1 attendance, we may need another day (Wednesday) of grade groupings. We want to ensure that once we have set our homerooms, we are confident that they will not need to be changed. At the end of Day 1, the plan for Wednesday will be sent out to families.

## Health & Safety:

At this time, we have not received any further changes to our current Covid Protocols, wearing a mask continues to be a personal choice. As a school, we will continue to practice frequent hand washing throughout the day to minimize the spread of germs.

To keep our entire school community healthy, we ask you to check-in with your child prior to sending them to school. If they are showing symptoms, please keep them home until they are symptom free. Our collective efforts in self-monitoring and health checks will help to keep our school community as healthy as possible.

# School Supplies Fee:

K-1: \$45 Plus a \$10 agenda charge for all students= \$55 total

2-3: \$50 Plus a \$10 agenda charge for all students= \$60 total

4-7: \$55 Plus a \$10 agenda charge for all students= \$65 total

# Parking Lot Safety: (continuation from last June)

Some families have chosen to park their vehicle when they need more time supporting their children during the morning transition, which has improved the flow of the drop-off lane.
